São Paulo City Tours



- ▶ A visit to Praça da Sé (the Cathedral Square), the exact central spot of the city;
- ▶ A tour around Liberdade, the Japanese neighborhood;
- ▶ A tour along Avenida Paulista (the charming Paulista Avenue);
- ▶ São Paulo University - Medical School;
- ▶ São Paulo University – Hospital das Clínicas (Clinic Hospital);
- ▶ São Paulo University City : the largest university campus in Brazil.
- ▶ A visit to **Butantã Institute** (Science Institute): Have a nice close look at the snakes in the serpentarium, enjoy a walk along the lanes of rare trees and an interesting visit to the Butantã Institute Museum (MIB).
- ▶ **Palácio dos Bandeirantes** – São Paulo State’s Government Headquarters.
- ▶ **Ibirapuera Park** – one of the greatest landmarks in São Paulo. A large open area containing special runways, sport fields, bike paths, lakes, trees and playgrounds, the Obelisco Monument to the heroes of the 1932’s Revolution and a monument to the “Bandeiras” (Bandeiras were expeditions of brave men who went inland to first explore gold and other precious minerals – It took place about a century after Brazil’s discovery)
- ▶ A tour around the luxurious neighborhood called Jardins.

São Paulo City is the Brazilian city which received most of the immigrants from all over the world in the past decades so its people come from different ethnicities. Lots of objects and places which helped build the Brazilian History can be found here. Travel back through old times and get to know its people and culture.

Itinerary:

- ▶A visit to Pátio do Colégio: the exact place where São Paulo City was founded.
- ▶A visit to the Sacred Art Museum: one of the most important catholic art collection in Brazil. More than a thousand pieces among them baroque art, several statues of saints and oratories can be admired there.
- ▶A visit to the Pinacoteca do Estado: one of the most important art museums in Brazil. There are about five thousand art objects, among them paintings, sculptures and artifacts of bronze, drawings and tapestries.
- ▶A tour around the first neighborhood founded by the elites and a visit to one of the most beautiful churches.

- ▶ Ipiranga Museum: a great art collection, antiques and the typical clothing from those old times.
- ▶ Immigration Museum: Find something about your family tree and enjoy a great exhibition of rare documents and objects, and the clothing of the people who immigrated to Brazil.
